

Must be read by the Auxiliary Secretary at the first meeting following receipt before being filed for reference.

1. All Auxiliaries that have not forwarded an Installation Report to the Department Secretary and National Secretary must do so immediately. You will not receive the renewal notice for the Treasurer's Bond, Program Book, or other essential information, without this report.

Auxiliaries that have not properly submitted an installation report to National by December 31, 2006 may have their charter cancelled by the National President.

Sisters, when we abide by our *Bylaws* where our duties are defined, our job becomes easier to handle and we become more accomplished. Whenever in doubt, check the *Bylaws* first!

2. I trust that all Auxiliary Presidents have complied with *Bylaws Sec. 810*: Presidents on all levels shall, within thirty (30) days after assuming the duties of her office, submit to the Commander of the corresponding unit of the VFW, an itemized report of the financial and membership status of her unit.
3. The Auxiliary President shall appoint a committee of no less than five (5) members, including the Treasurer, to contact all members during the year for payment of dues. They shall also contact those who have not paid dues for the preceding years. For more information, refer to Section 810A of the *Bylaws*.
4. The term of office for which District Delegates are elected shall be one year from date of election, as described in Section 303, until the election of the new delegates.
5. Auxiliaries and Districts are permitted to have only two (2) signatures on the Auxiliary bank account. The National Bylaws, Article VIII, Sections 810A and 810C, sets forth that the President shall countersign all checks.
6. A copy of the Treasurer's Report shall be incorporated in the Secretary minutes.
7. A non-member widow of an eligible veteran who has married a man not eligible for the Veterans of Foreign Wars is eligible for membership in the Ladies Auxiliary through her deceased husband. Please refer to *Bylaws*, Section 114.
8. The Department Council of Administration meeting will be held Saturday, October 7, 2006, in Mechanicsville at 3rd District Headquarters at 10:00 a.m. All are welcome to attend.
9. POW-MIA RECOGNITION DAY: Is Friday, September 15, 2006. Auxiliaries please work with your VFW members, to educate our communities and have a proper ceremony for those Missing in Action and held Prisoners of War.
10. NATIONAL PRESIDENTS HOMECOMING: National President Linda Meader's Homecoming will be held in North Conway, NH the weekend of September 28-October 1, 2006. All members are invited to attend this special weekend with the National President. For information, please contact the Department Secretary, Susie DeShano.

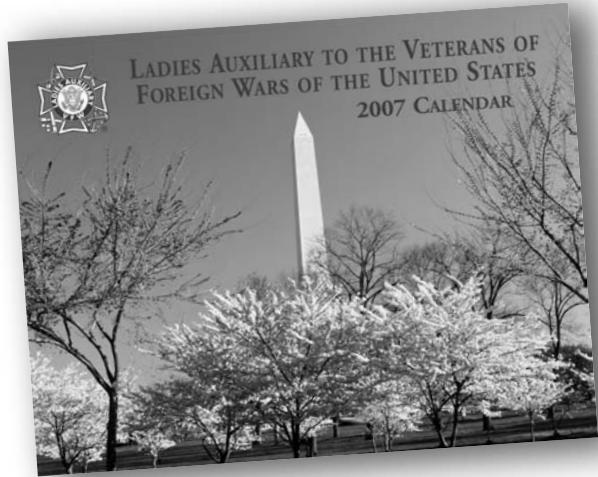
